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
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

SUMMARY OF SHUTTER ISLAND

Shutter Island is one of the novel by Dennis Lehane that have been adapted into films. The film has Leonardo DiCaprio playing U.S. Marshal Teddy Daniels, "who is investigating the disappearance of a patient who escaped from a hospital for the criminally insane and is presumed to be hiding on the remote Shutter Island." Mark Ruffalo played opposite DiCaprio as U.S. Marshal Chuck Aule. The two marshal Teddy Daniels and Chuck Aule came to the Shutter Island to investigate the missing patient in Aschecliffe Hospital for the criminally insane patient. Rachel Solando, the missing patient who was imprison for drowning her three children. Their only clue is a piece of paper with a pyramid letters found in Rachel's room. The abbreviated of the letters are: "The law of 4; who is 67?"

When investigating, the two marshal find something weird about the hospital. First, the hospital let Dr. Sheehan, Rachel's primary psychiatrist to take a vacation on the next morning after Rachel escaped. Second, the hospital didn't give them the personal data of Dr. Sheehan that can help to make the investigation easier. Third, the patient that their interviewed seems like she was coached of what to say and she secretlyly writes the word "RUN" in Teddy notebook's. The situation become weirder when Rachel has abruptly resurfaced with no explanation as to her former whereabouts or how she escaped, the two marshal didn't get notified of Rachel's returned.

Chapter 1: Teddy Daniels and Chuck Aule on the ferry boat to the mental hospital for the criminally insane patient in Shutter Island.

Chapter 2: The hospital has three Ward, WardA, Ward B, and Ward C. Ward A in for the male patient, Ward B is for the female patient, and Ward C is for the most dangerous patient. Teddy and Chuck can go into Ward A and Ward B freely, but not to Ward C. To go into Ward C they must have the written consent and physical presence of both the warden and Dr. Cawley.

Chapter 5: Teddy asks for personal file of Dr. Sheehan but Dr. Naehring (Dr. Cawley colleague) doesn't allow it. Teddy decides to quit the investigation. Teddy thought Rachel's escaped was with the help of the whole institution so it is useless to keep going with that investigation.

Chapter 6: Teddy dreams of dead woman named Dolores, she says in his dream that Rachel is here, she still in that hospital. Teddy can't quit the investigation, she also says that Laeddis is here too. On five in the morning, Teddy decides to break Rachel's code. By one hour passed he succeed in breaking the code. Teddy decides to keep going with the investigation.

Chapter 7: Teddy explains the meaning of Rachel's code to Cawley and Chuck. He says that it's not 'the law of four' but law of thirteen. It can be seen in Rachel's name, Rachel Solando has thirteen letters. Teddy says that the code follows the most rudimentary principle of number-to-letter assignation. The 'I' on the first line of Rachel's code refers to her first name. Teddy also says that 'They' on the second line of Rachel's code refers to her last name Solando. He was the maintenance man in the apartment building where he and his wife lived. He lit the match that caused the fire that killed his wife, Dolores (the dead woman in his dream).

Chapter 8: Chuck begins to questioning Teddy about his real purpose to go to this hospital. Teddy says he really is here for Rachel Solando, but if meet up with Laeddis then he will only talk with him, or maybe threaten him that as long as

Teddy alive free air isn't something he breathes. Teddy also tells Chuck about the patient that give him a message "run" on his notebook.

Chapter 9: Teddy tells Chuck that he was sent to that hospital to gather information. It started with Laeddis, a year ago. That said had been transferred to Aschecliffe, but when Teddy call the hospital they claim to have no record of him.

Chapter 10: The hospital still doesn't help the two marshal by not giving them the access to staff and patient files that can be important information in order to find Rachel, but then Cawley says that Rachel Solando had been found.

Chapter 11: Dr. Cawley and Dr. Naehring led the two marshal to Rachel's room to meet her. Teddy asks her where have she been. But she said that she was there, she was home. Teddy asks the Dr. Where did they find her. Cawley says on the beach near the lighthouse, skipping stones into the oceans.

Chapter 12: Teddy got a nigtmares he keeps saying his wife name in his sleep.

He then tells Dr. Cawley about his wife, Dolores. He tells him that he still trying to get over with it.

Chapter 13: While Teddy reminiscing his past with his wife. He decides to find Andrew Laeddis. He wants to take revenge of his wife's death. He's going to kill Laeddis.

Chapter 14: Teddy and Chuck got into Ward C. Teddy end up saving some guard from the patient that escaped.

Chapter 15: Teddy encounters George Noyce, he warns Teddy that everyone else on the island is playing an elaborate game specifically designed for Teddy and

that he must not trust his partner Chuck. Noyce also tells Teddy that if he does not save him, then the hospital staff will brought him to the lighthouse to cut out his brain. Teddy promises Noyce that he will go to the lighthouse and see what happens there, and he promises to bring Noyce out of that hospital.

Chapter 16: Teddy keeps searching for more clues by counting the rocks in that island and then he write it on his notebook with their alphabetical assignation. When climb up the cliff Chuck went missing.

Chapter 17: Teddy see that Chuck's body lay at the bottom of the cliff. When he climb down the cliff to saves him, he found nothing but a long narrow rock covered in seaweed. He shouted Chuck name but got no answered. When Teddy climb up the cliff, he see a cave and find that someone in it. He think it was Chuck, but turn out it was someone else. A woman wore a patient's light pink shirt. That someone admitted that she is the "real Rachel Solando". She is not the patient, but the former doctor of the hospital that imprisoned as the patient because she began to wonder aloud about the large shipments of Sodium Amytal and opium-based halucinogens. Chapter 19: It occurred to Teddy that Chuck was kidnap by the hospital. They try to manipulate him with the mind game.

Chapter 20: Teddy try to go to the lighthouse to find Chuck. He thinks that Chuck was taken to there. When he got to that lighthouse he meets Cawley. Cawley didn't look startled. He didn't look scared.

Chapter 21: Teddy tells Cawley that he met the "real Rachel Solando. When investigating, Teddy felt symptoms like headache, dry mouth and shakes. He thought that it was from neuroleptics that he smoked in Cawley cigarettes. Cawley tells that all of the symptoms Teddy feels was not from neuroleptics but it was from withdrawals. Cawley tells Teddy that he's been here for two years. He is the patient on Aschecliffe hospital. Cawley tells Teddy that he is actually the sixty-seven patient in that mental hospital. His name, Andrew's name, his wife's name, and Rachel's name were anagram to each other. The rule of 4 that was found in Rachel's bedroom is his, he is the one who made it.
