CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

The researcher applies the theory from (Yule, 1996) regarding illocutionary speech acts and the theory from (Searle, 1979) regarding classification of illocutionary speech acts; declarative, representative, expressive, directive, and commissive.

Based on the results of the analysis in Chapter IV, in Mata Najwa's video interview entitled "Exclusive Interview with Chris Martin of Coldplay" on Najwa Shihab's YouTube channel the researcher found utterances containing illocutionary speech acts and classification of illocutionary speech acts based on theory from (Searle, 1979). The researcher found declaration act (2 utterances), representative act (19 utterances), expressive act (25 utterances), directive act (4 utterances), and commissive acts (4 utterances) in the video interview between Najwa Shihab and Chris Martin.

With this result the researcher concludes that in video interview between Najwa Shihab and Chris Martin it contains illocutionary speech acts and each classification from both the interviewer and the guest.

5.2 Suggestion

In this sub-chapter, the researcher provides some suggestions related to this research as follows:

1. For further researchers

The researcher suggests to future researchers who are interested in researching speech acts, especially illocutionary speech acts, to have a deeper understanding of the classification using data in the form of interviews or other data sources. Future researchers are expected to be able to use different data and theories in order to be able to compare with other studies.

2. For readers

The researcher hopes that this research can provide useful information for the readers regarding illocutionary speech acts and their classifications.

3. For institutions

The researcher hopes that this research can become good and useful educational material for students and the institution itself, especially in the field of language and linguistics so that they are more motivated.

Chris: I think maybe I saw someone yesterday say Indonesia was maybe number one, so anyway wherever it's number one number three we're so happy and grateful.

Najwa: Does that surprise you?

Chris : No, because you guys are awesome when you have very good taste.

Najwa: Yes! Yes! So, I want to tell you this during that concert in Bangkok and I was there with my family and friends and you give this shout out "to the Indonesian fans that flew all the way to Bangkok, thank you" do you remember saying that? because it meant so much.

Chris: Well, I try and I try and say thank you to whoever I can I always forget somebody so I'm happy that I didn't forget you.

Najwa: I think I remember leaving the concert feeling this overwhelmingly joy and how everyone seems so connected somehow and I think to anyone who's ever been to Coldplay concerts that's the main feeling the feeling of joy and happy and just this really strong connection with you.

Chris: Well, that's very kind, um I think the truth is we need that connection to maintain our faith in humanity. I need to feel that connection with other humans because especially now it's very easy to feel isolated or alone or scared by the world and the truth is most people are kind, good people and they love other people and they just want to be free to be themselves and let everybody else be themselves and I feel that our concert is becoming a place where that's possible where you can be yourself, you don't judge anybody else and that's how we feel too, we really love everybody's individual Magic.

Najwa: And your songs are always so powerful, it relates to so many people different backgrounds, different generations, religions, ethnicity. What is the key ingredients in making such a powerful music?

Chris: Well, I don't really know where music comes from. I just receive it, uh but I think the thing that our souls have is they are all true. So, it might not appeal to everybody because not everybody will be feeling that way that day or not everybody likes that kind of music or that not everybody likes to hear me sing but all of our songs come from a place of real genuine emotion, right? so everything we sing about is something that we've felt or I felt myself and often those songs are a message to myself of how to handle life. So, maybe it's that...

Najwa: Uh, Chris I watch your interview I think it was back in 2009 when you said that the goal is to make that perfect song and then you add it that it will probably never happen. Fast forward now almost 15 years later, do you think you have reached that goal or have the goal changes?

Chris: No, we have not reached that goal but we keep trying, um the goal changes? No, the goal is still there but I think I accept that it's like a mystical thing that maybe will never get to, but the joy is in trying I think and I think we've made some really good songs, but uh there are some songs by other people that I think are perfect songs but not none of ours yet but maybe tomorrow will change.

Najwa: I think all your songs are perfect, I think I'm fangirling over here but I think all Coldplay songs are perfectly Coldplay.

Chris: Well, that's very kind and that means a lot to me.

Najwa: You've met such a bold commitment to sustain ability in your concert. Can you share a bit more about that?

Chris : Yes, when we were deciding whether to go on tour, we said Well we'd love to tour but we need to change how we consume energy and how we need to stop taking and stop giving in some ways in terms of the environment and so we employed a few people to help us clean up our show in terms of the power, in terms of transport, everything. To look at the whole thing how can we improve the transport, how can we improve where we get the lights from our everything and um it's become a very important part of the tour and it's something that's always ongoing and we're always trying to improve right now, I think we have like 45% clean their shower than last time but we're still only one year in so by the end we'll get more and more clean but it's become as important as the music in some ways because of course with no Earth there is no music. So, we felt like well we have a responsibility to do whatever we can do in our business and hopefully other people in their business will do what they can do, but uh it's become very fun it's also a cool in our show because we have a few places where people can interact with some of that equipment there's a kinetic floor where you can jump up and down and create power some bicycles where they create power or anybody that buys a ticket we plant a tree. So, things like that are really fun.

Najwa: And will all that cool Technologies also be in Jakarta show?

Chris: Yeah.

Najwa: Great! Great! What I find really interesting and you also mentioned this before is that um by doing this you are proving that being clean and green can be a part of any successful business so this is not just about making a point or being correct.

Chris: No, we're trying to show and it takes a little time. We are trying to show that being clean and green is good business. Right, it's not something charitable that's not something that means you lose quality of life but it's something that should just be natural part of any business if you want the business to do well.

Najwa: Great! That's just amazing.

Najwa: You know Chris the tickets are not even on sale yet here but the fans have been going crazy with anticipations they've even coming up with plans and strategies on how to get the tickets, they're preparing for ticket Wars it's just been nuts here in Jakarta in Indonesia.

Chris: Well, I don't know how to respond to that. That's very sweet but we want everyone to be safe and you know I'm sure we'll come back so don't panic too much.

Najwa: Actually, at the risk of sounding ungrateful but I have to ask you this on behalf of the fans. What are the chances of having more than one show here in Jakarta.

Chris: I don't know.

Najwa: Okay, we're keeping our fingers are crossed.

Chris: We'll see, we'll see. I will speak to my boss which is Phil.

Chris: I'll tell him you love him and I'll see what he says.
