

## CHAPTER V CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter presents the summary of the key findings derived from the analysis of Emma Chamberlain's slang usage, specifically through the lens of the Ideational Metafunction. Following the conclusions, suggestions for future research and practical implications for content creators are provided.

### 5.1 Conclusions

This research aimed to investigate the characteristics and communicative purposes of Emma Chamberlain's slang in her YouTube content and to analyze its influence on young viewers' engagement and loyalty. Based on the detailed linguistic analysis of selected videos—"Trying Viral TikTok Recipes" (January 2023), "A Day in My Life" (July 2021), and "Reacting to My Old Videos" (November 2021)—through the framework of Halliday's Ideational Metafunction, the following conclusions are drawn.

Firstly, this study identified diverse slang types, including evaluative and reactional slang (e.g., 'fire', 'shook'), authenticity and feeling-related slang (e.g., 'vibing', 'no cap', 'ngl'), and humorous reactional slang (e.g., 'cringe', 'dying'). These types mark her distinctive communication and resonate with her audience. Secondly, Emma Chamberlain's slang serves crucial communicative purposes by effectively construing her subjective experiences, emotions, and evaluations. Realized through various process types (Mental, Relational, Behavioral), her slang precisely represents her internal reality and external observations. This consistent and candid linguistic choice fundamentally shapes her identity as an authentic, relatable, and humorous content creator, fostering a strong bond and shared reality with her audience.

Finally, the ideational function of her slang exerts a profound influence on audience engagement and loyalty. This influence is achieved as the slang, through its vivid construction of shared linguistic and experiential worlds, precisely enhances viewer relatability. Such profound relatability, in turn, directly fosters a strong sense of community among viewers and significantly strengthens parasocial

relationships. Consequently, viewers perceive Emma Chamberlain not merely as a distant celebrity but as a trusted peer, a connection that is instrumental in driving their consistent engagement and cementing their long-term loyalty to her content and personal brand.

## 5.2 Suggestions

Based on the findings and limitations of this study, the following suggestions are offered for future research and for content creators and practitioners in the digital media landscape. For future research, expanding linguistic analysis to include Interpersonal and Textual Metafunctions is recommended for a more holistic understanding of slang's multifaceted roles. Comparative studies across different YouTube creators, content genres, or social media platforms could reveal variations in slang functions and reception. Employing mixed-methods, such as quantitative surveys or qualitative interviews, would provide direct audience insights into how viewers interpret and are influenced by slang. Additionally, longitudinal analysis of slang evolution is suggested to track the emergence, adoption, and obsolescence of terms over time, shedding light on linguistic innovation. Finally, exploring multimodal analysis of slang, investigating how it interacts with non-linguistic elements like facial expressions and editing in video content, would offer deeper insights into meaning creation. For content creators and practitioners, it is crucial to recognize slang not merely as informal language but as a strategic tool for effectively construing relatable experiences and building authentic identities with niche audiences. Prioritizing authenticity through natural slang usage is vital, as it significantly enhances audience engagement and loyalty, particularly when targeting younger demographics. Furthermore, investing in understanding the specific ideational meanings and cultural nuances of slang relevant to the target audience is key to maintaining credibility and avoiding misuse. Lastly, when aspiring for wider appeal or mainstream collaborations, creators should strategically balance authenticity with broader appeal, adjusting their linguistic choices based on communicative goals.
