

## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

### 5.1. Conclusion

A comprehensive analysis of the data collected from the *Marah-Marah* Community revealed a notable increase in linguistic activity during the month of April, indicating a vibrant and dynamic use of language within this group. The researcher meticulously identified a total of 200 distinct language registers, which were categorized based on their formality and usage. Among these, a substantial majority of 185 registers were classified as informal, highlighting the community's preference for a relaxed and familiar communication style. Additionally, 15 registers were identified as colloquial, further emphasizing the use of everyday language that resonates with the members' shared experiences and cultural context. This prevalence of informal language within the marah-marah community serves to foster emotional closeness among its members, as it allows individuals to express their feelings and thoughts in a more personal and relatable manner. By utilizing such informal and colloquial expressions, community members are able to create a supportive environment where emotional vulnerability is encouraged, ultimately strengthening their interpersonal connections and enhancing the overall sense of belonging within the group.

The research revealed that the Informal register was the most prevalent, with a total of 185 occurrences, reflecting the use of relaxed and familiar language in daily conversations among netizens. Expressions of emotion and disappointment are often reflected in the use of informal registers, which also tend to include abbreviations and other linguistic elements. This suggests that language can serve as a conduit for conveying feelings during social interactions. The high number of informal register occurrences can be explained by the need for netizens to communicate quickly and efficiently. It can also be explained by the need to create closeness and familiarity in online interactions. Additionally, the use of colloquial registers resulted in 15 instances of linguistic variety, showcasing that despite the casual nature of the language, it possesses nuanced expressions. This

shows that, despite the informal context, netizens are still able to convey deep and meaningful messages.

## 5.2. Suggestion

In future research, it'd be a good idea to compare the registers used in the Marah-Marah community with those used in other online communities. That'd help us understand the differences and similarities in language use in various contexts. Also, it's important to look at how the community's emotions influence word choice and sentence structure. Research could also look into how social media affects language choice, as well as how other users respond to different linguistic styles, including any unwritten rules or norms that may exist. Demographic aspects such as age, gender, and educational background should be looked into too, to see how register usage differs. On top of analyzing text, taking a look at the visual stuff, like memes or images, used in the Marah Marah community and how they interact with language will also give us some extra insights. Finally, conducting interviews or focus group discussions with community members can help us understand why certain registers are used the way they are.
