

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusions

An examination of Tangerang City's park names demonstrates the close relationship that exists between the local identity, cultural values, and environmental awareness. The goals, connections, and values that the local populace has for their surroundings are reflected in each of the fifteen parks that were examined. These parks' names reflect the community's dedication to sustainability, cultural heritage, and social interaction in addition to identifying specific physical areas. For example, *Pintu Air* emphasizes the value of water as a vital resource, signifying life and the necessity of conservation, while *Eco Park* stresses environmental awareness and the significance of coexisting with nature. As a haven from pollution and a reminder of ecological responsibility, *Taman Hutan Kota* City Forest emphasizes the value of green spaces in urban environments. In a similar vein, *Taman Herbal* serves as a health and wellness education center and represents the community's love of natural remedies and traditional medicine. By offering spaces for celebration and cross-cultural interaction, parks such as *Alun-Alun Kota Tangerang* and *Taman Prestasi* promote social cohesiveness and community pride. The names *Taman Dayung* and *Taman Nobar* highlight the value of leisure and recreational pursuits in fostering social bonds. Additionally, parks like *Taman Bambu* and *Taman Gajah Tunggal* highlight environmental awareness and solidarity while reflecting local cultural values. All things considered, the linguistic landscapes of these parks demonstrate the community's commitment to creating a lively, harmonious, and sustainable urban environment, emphasizing how vital these parks are to the community's identity and general well being.

5.2 Suggestions

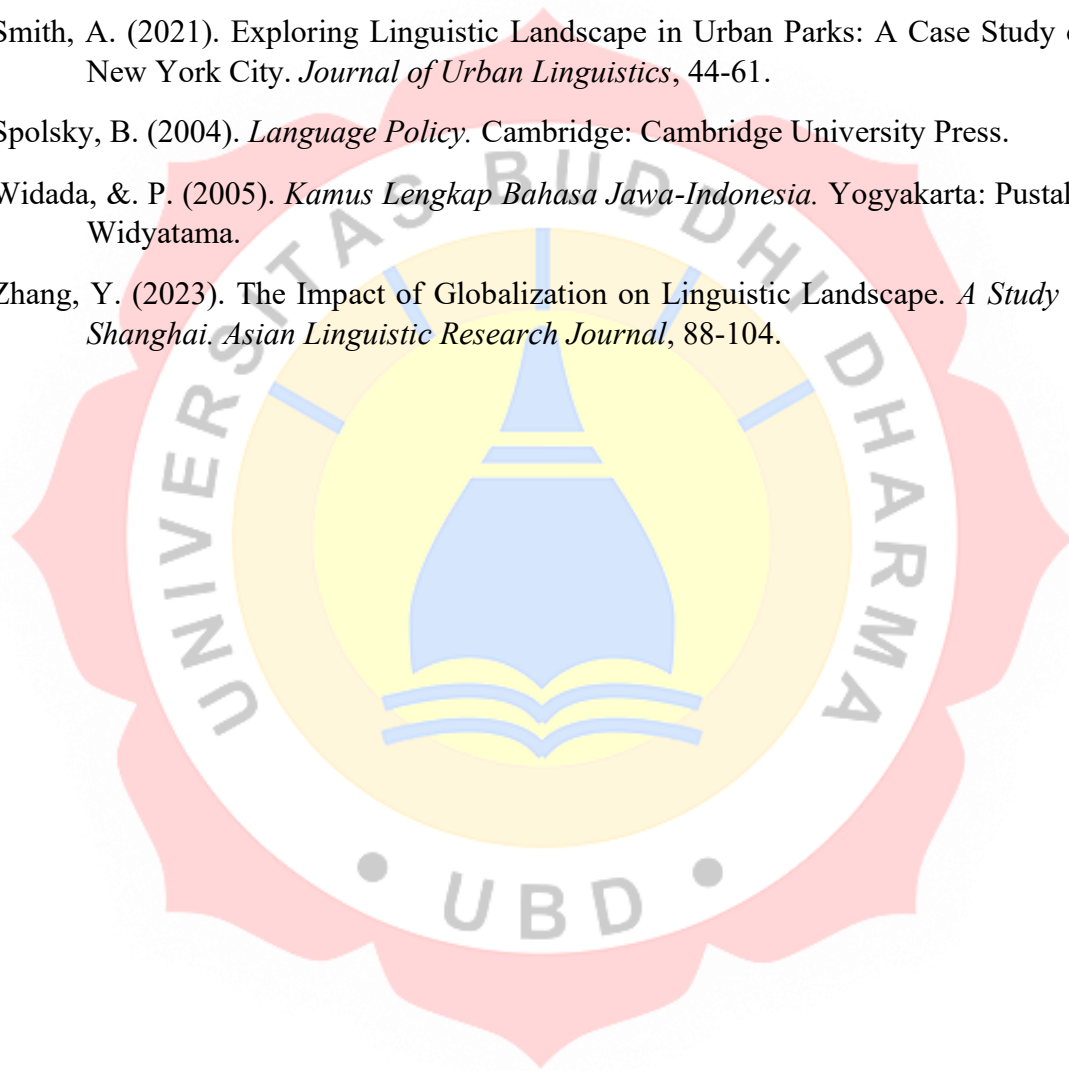
Several specific recommendations can be made to further strengthen Tangerang City's parks' function as essential community areas. First, community engagement programs that actively promote park participation, like environmental clean-up days,

sustainability education workshops, and cultural events honoring regional customs, should be put into place by local government agencies. Residents who are more involved feel more accountable and have a greater sense of ownership over the upkeep and improvement of these areas. Second, holding frequent cultural and educational activities in the parks can help spread knowledge about local heritage, customs, and environmental issues. Events like workshops on medicinal plants, art exhibits, and traditional music concerts can draw a wide range of people and foster cross-cultural interaction. Third, making improvements to park amenities is essential to raising the standard of the entire visitor experience. This includes making sure that there is enough seating, restrooms, and recreational equipment, as well as making sure that people with disabilities can access the space. Fourth, to encourage environmental stewardship and act as educational resources for tourists, parks should integrate sustainable practices like rainwater collection and native plant landscaping. Fifth, the parks' function as community centers can be strengthened by forming alliances with neighborhood, educational, and community organizations. This will allow for the sharing of resources and expand the range of programs available. Lastly, to increase awareness of the parks' offerings and motivate locals to visit and use them more often, efficient communication techniques should be used to advertise them on social media, in neighborhood newsletters, and at neighborhood gatherings. Tangerang City can further strengthen the value of its parks as venues for social interaction, cultural expression, and environmental awareness by putting these recommendations into practice, which will ultimately result in a more lively and cohesive urban environment.

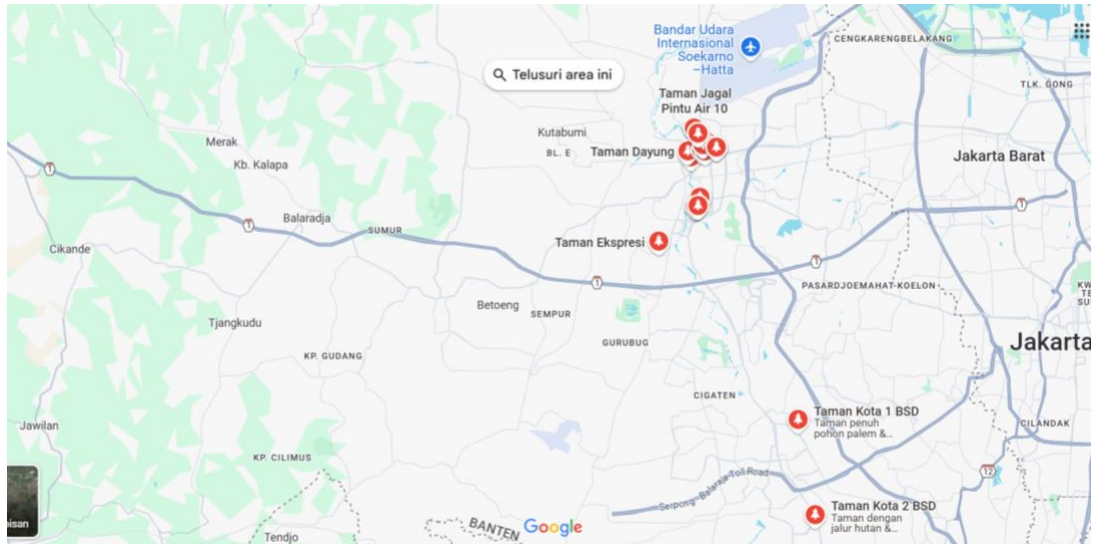

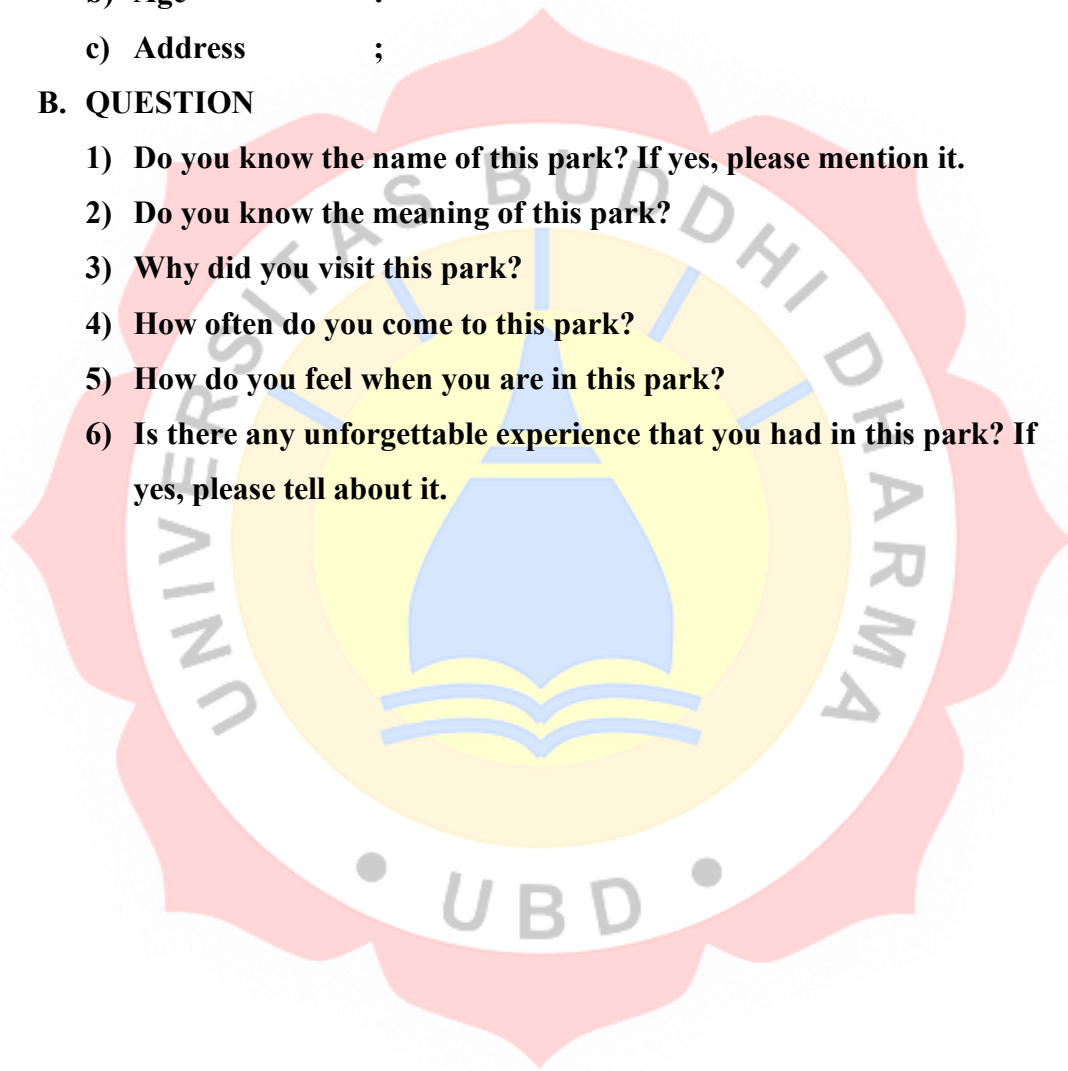

INTERVIEW REPORT

In this section, the results of the interviews conducted with the informants regarding the meaning behind the naming of graves will be presented in the form of a narrative report. This report contains descriptions and responses from the informants to a number of questions listed in the interview guide. At the end of the section, a brief profile of the interviewed informants will also be presented.

1. *Alun-alun Kota Tangerang*

Name : Rima
Age : 25 Years old
Address : Perumnas 1

Based on an interview with one of the informants, it was discovered that he was familiar with Alun-Alun Kota Tangerang. When asked about the name of the place, the informant immediately replied that he knew it was a town square located in the center of Tangerang City. Furthermore, the informant also understood the function and significance of Alun-Alun Kota Tangerang as a public open space intended for the wider community to engage in communal activities. According to the informant, the place was designed to be used by a wide range of groups for various purposes, from sports to family recreation.

The informant's reason for visiting Alun-Alun Kota Tangerang was for exercise. He explained that the place has adequate areas for physical activities, such as jogging or gymnastics, and the atmosphere is quite conducive to maintaining physical fitness. When asked about how often he visits the place, the informant explained that he usually visits the square once a week, especially during his free time or on weekends.

The interviewee's experience at Alun-Alun Kota Tangerang was quite positive. He was pleased that, in addition to being a sports venue, the square also offers various other supporting facilities, such as a children's play area, food vendors, and street food stalls, adding to the lively and welcoming atmosphere for

visitors. The bustling yet orderly atmosphere was a major draw for the interviewee and other visitors.

When asked about a memorable experience at Alun-Alun Kota Tangerang, the interviewee stated that while he didn't have a specific experience, he found it quite memorable due to its strategic location, easy access, and comfortable atmosphere, which was better than other public places. He also mentioned that the improved facilities and cleanliness of the area contributed to the visitor's comfort every time they visited. As a result, Alun-Alun Kota Tangerang has become one of his favorite places to do activities and relax with family or friends.

2. *Taman Cikokol*

Name : Anna
Age : 27 Years old
Address : Sangiang

Based on an interview with one of the informants regarding Taman Cikokol, it was discovered that the informant was familiar with the name of the park. He stated that he knew the park was called Taman Cikokol and was quite familiar with its location. When asked to explain the meaning of the park's name, the informant suggested that the name "Cikoko" might refer to the name of the area where the park is located, thus reflecting the local identity of the area.

The informant's reasons for visiting Taman Cikokol were its accessible location and easy access. He found the park to be a convenient open space to visit when he wanted to relax or unwind without having to travel far. However, he did not visit the park very often. He stated that he had only visited the park about two or three times, usually when he had free time or was in the area.

When asked about his feelings during his visit to Taman Cikokol, the interviewee expressed his delight because the park was quite busy with visitors, yet still maintained its cleanliness. The lively atmosphere, coupled with the relatively clean and well-maintained park area, made the visit feel comfortable. According to the interviewee, the park is quite pleasant as a public space that is welcoming to all groups.

The interviewee's most memorable experience during his visit to Taman Cikokol was spending time with his younger sibling. This simple moment was enjoyable and memorable, as they were able to enjoy time together in a refreshing open space. For the interviewee, memories like these make Taman Cikokol a special place, even if they don't visit it often.

3. *Taman Nobar*

Name : Rahma

Age : 18 Years old

Address : Perumnas 2

An interview with one of the informants revealed that he was familiar with the name of Taman Nobar, a public space located in an area he frequently passes through. When asked about the meaning of the park's name, the informant suggested that "Nobar" likely comes from the abbreviation "monton bareng" (watching together), given that this place is often used by people to gather and watch events together, especially during special occasions such as sporting events or other entertainment.

The informant's reason for visiting Taman Nobar was not for a specific purpose, but rather because he happened to be passing through the area. He explained that his visit to the park was unplanned, merely passing through while doing activities in the area. Therefore, the informant also stated that he doesn't visit the park very often. His visits to the park are more coincidental and less frequent, unlike other parks where people might go for exercise or relaxation.

Despite this, the interviewee's feelings during their time at Taman Nobar remained positive. They were pleased to find the park bustling with visitors and a wide variety of appealing snacks available. The crowds didn't make them uncomfortable; instead, they gave the park a lively and festive feel. This, they believe, is what makes Taman Nobar a uniquely appealing interactive public space.

The interviewee's most memorable experience at the park was the creative food offerings. According to them, the vendors around the park offered a variety of unique and unusual snacks, creating a delightful culinary experience. Although

their visit to the park was casual and unplanned, the creativity of the atmosphere and the food vendors made Taman Nobar leave a pleasant impression on them.

4. *Taman Ekspresi*

Name : Putra

Age : 26 Years old

Address : Sabi Village

In an interview with one of the informants, it was discovered that he was familiar with the name "Taman Ekspresi." He explained that the park is quite well-known in his neighborhood and is a frequent destination for activities for both children and parents. When asked to explain the meaning of the park's name, the informant explained that "Taman Ekspresi" is a park designed for children to play and express themselves. He explained that the park provides a space for children to interact, play with friends, and build social relationships. In other words, the park provides a place for children to explore themselves in a fun atmosphere.

The informant's reasons for visiting the park were its proximity to home and its beautiful, natural setting. He mentioned that the park is still surrounded by shady trees, a clean environment, and a well-maintained atmosphere. This is what makes him feel comfortable taking his children to play there, especially in the morning. He doesn't visit the park very often, only at certain times, such as when his children want to play or when he has a day off from work. The source also added that he comes more often in the morning because the atmosphere is fresher and busier, while at night it tends to be quiet.

The interviewee's experience at Taman Ekspresi was very positive, both as a parent and from a child's perspective. She enjoyed being able to relax, sometimes even enjoying a coffee, while her child freely played in the spacious park area with its various games. Another advantage was that parents could monitor their children from a distance, providing both freedom and security. According to the interviewee, this is crucial in providing a healthy and enjoyable space for children's growth and development.

One of the most memorable experiences for the interviewee at Taman Ekspresi was witnessing her child's social development. She shared that the park helped her child learn to socialize, become confident in talking to new people, and make many friends. Interactions in the park made her child more confident in communicating, even with strangers. For the interviewee, this experience added value to the park as a public space that not only provides a place to play but also supports the development of children's character in social life.

5. Eco Park

Name : Dika

Age : 30 Years old

Address : Cikokol

One of the informants was interviewed, and it was discovered that he knew a great deal about Eco Park. According to him, this park is a green open space with an emphasis on environmental preservation. When asked what the park's name means, the informant explained that "Eco" stands for ecology, which reflects the park's mission to promote environmental awareness and sustainability. The informant goes to Eco Park to work out and unwind. He appreciates the abundance of shade-giving trees and the natural ambiance. Twice a week, he usually goes to the park, especially to jog in the morning.

The informant goes to Eco Park for exercise and relaxation. He enjoys the natural setting and the abundance of trees for shade. He usually goes to the park twice a week, especially in the morning for jogging. The informant's experience at Eco Park was very positive. He is satisfied with the available amenities, such as jogging trails and picnic areas. The informant also mentioned that the park frequently hosts interesting environmental events, which make him feel more involved in the community. The informant's most memorable experience at Eco Park was participating in a community tree planting event. According to him, the activity was not only enjoyable, but it also gave him a sense of belonging in the environment.

6. *Taman Pintu Air*

Name : Siti
Age : 28 Years old
Address : Karawaci

In an interview with the informant, he stated that he knew *Taman Pintu Air* as a park with unusual and intriguing water features. The informant explained that “*Pintu Air*” refers to the park's irrigation system. The informant went to *Taman Pintu Air* to *unwind* and enjoy the atmosphere. QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS





The majority of respondents defined parks as green open spaces used for various community activities, such as relaxing, playing, and expressing themselves. Some parks were defined based on their location and function, such as the Dayung Park, which is synonymous with rowing competitions on the Cisadane River; the Expression Park, which serves as a place for children to express themselves; the Bamboo Park, which represents strength and resilience; and the Portrait Park, which is considered an arts education park. Parks are also understood as places for recreation, learning, and environmental preservation that provide cultural and social value to the community. Respondents' reasons for visiting the park varied. Some came to exercise, relax, play with their children or younger siblings, or simply stopped by while passing by. Others visited to enjoy the tranquil atmosphere, fill their free time, or watch special events like dragon boat races. Parks were also chosen as places to chat with friends or partners due to their comfortable atmosphere and easy access. Most respondents felt happy, comfortable, and peaceful while in the park. They enjoyed the cool, shady atmosphere and the park's natural beauty. The presence of play facilities, snacks, and comfortable seating added to the positive impression. Some felt the park provided a sense of calm and positive energy, perfect for unwinding. Furthermore, the park provided a pleasant social experience, especially for children who could play and socialize with their friends.
